

WriteVue: MSCS Benchmark Writing Data Dashboard for Administrators

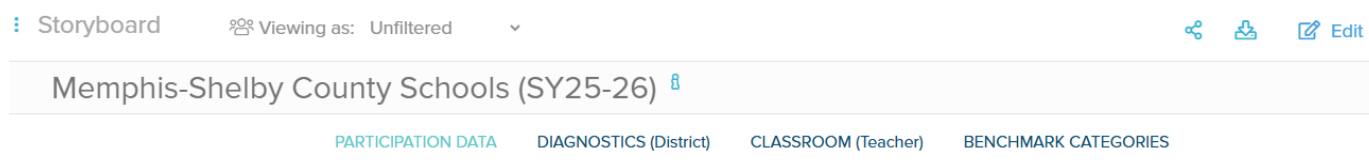
School level administrators see data for their school only, whereas **district level administrators** can sort by school or region. **Teachers & students** see scores and writing in their MY Access! Portfolio.

Logging in:

We have streamlined the login process for the 26-27 school year. Go to app.writevue.com to log in. If this is your first time logging in this year, select “Forgot Password” and follow the steps to create a new password. Use your school email address as your username. *If you are unable to change your password, it means your MSCS username has not yet been entered into the WriteVue system for 26-27. 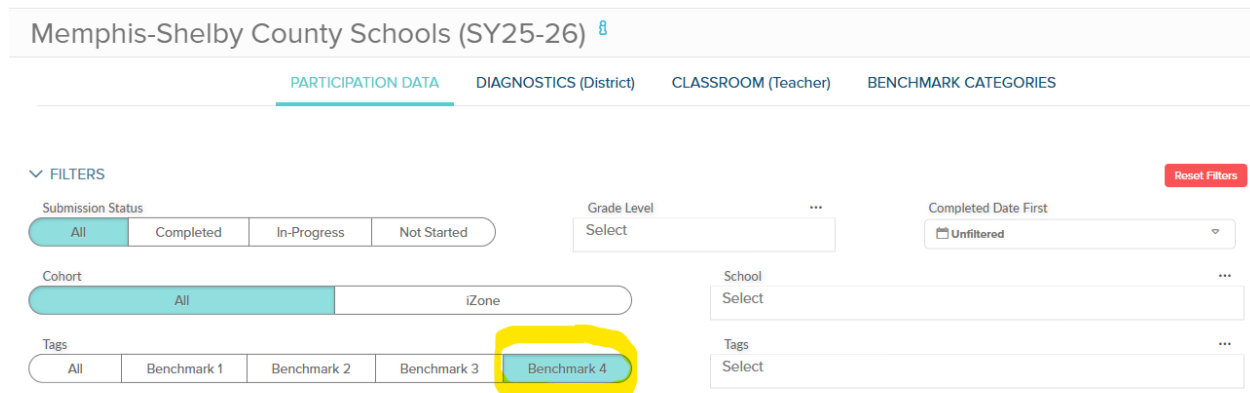
The WriteVue Dashboard:

There are **4 tabs** on top. They may be in a slightly different order than shown here:



- **Participation:** Shows which students in your school have started, completed, and not started the benchmarks.
- **Diagnostics:** Shows various displays of score data for each benchmark diagnostic by whole school, grade, class, and student.
- **Classroom (teacher):** Shows data related to assignments teachers have created and assigned to students in MY Access! outside of the benchmarks.
- **Benchmark Categories for Comparison:** Lists all MSCS 26-27 benchmark titles and genres for each grade level. It also shows the rubrics that help users understand the score types shown in the data displays.

Filtering in for Data: On each tab, you can select which benchmark data to view. *The other filters are generally left on the default.*



To Compare Benchmark Scores:

Go to the “Diagnostics” tab.

Put the 3 filters on the left to “All”.

Under “Tags” on the right, click “Select” to show each benchmark on a list.

All diagnostic assessments are scored using a 6-point rubric:

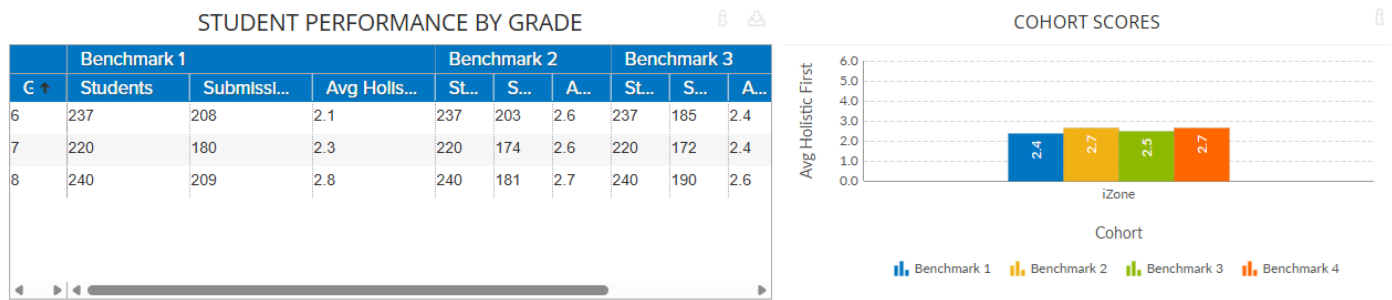
Above Proficient: 5.0-6.0

Proficient: 4.0-4.9

Approaching Proficient: 3.0-3.9

Below Proficient: 0.0-2.9

District administrators see two displays close the top that show a comparison of scores. Both show the average holistic (proficiency) scores: one is by grade and one is by region. School administrators will see the comparison by grade only.



As you scroll down you will see different data displays that show scores by grade level, teacher, assignment, and student. **All of these displays can be downloaded as Excel sheets.** There is a light gray arrow in the right-hand corner that the user clicks to create an Excel sheet.

Any time there is a +, the user can click on it to see a deeper level of data.

All of the column sizes are adjustable by dragging the border of the column in one direction.

Some displays may contain the same information, but the titles of each display indicate what data will be downloaded to an Excel sheet. For example, if a user simply wants to download the overall holistic scores by grade level, the data display with that title will show scores by grade level but will *not* populate teacher, assignment, & student data onto the Excel sheet, while the one titled “Holistic Scores- Downloadable by Student” will.
